

**A Healing Panel:** Youth in South Africa's Royal Bafokeng Nation and the Washington, DC metropolitan area will come together with mental health experts to discuss their experiences throughout this year, explore mental health challenges youth face in their communities, and gain tools to help them develop healthy coping skills.

**Soothing Painting:** An art therapy painting session will enable youth in the Royal Bafokeng Nation and Washington, DC metropolitan area, that participated in the mental health panel, to express their experiences and emotions through painting.

**An Action-Packed Live Auction:** Art from South African and American artists will go to the highest bidder from our live and silent art auction. Bids will open 48 hours before and conclude during the event.

**Compelling Speakers:** Invited guest speakers include His Majesty Kgosi Leruo Molotlegi, King of the Royal Bafokeng Nation; Ambassador Nomaindiya Mfeketo, South African Ambassador to the United States of America; Muriel Bowser, Mayor of Washington, DC; Charlamagne tha God; Biso Gxashe, and the Black Wendy.

**Captivating Entertainment:** Invited performers include but aren't limited to South Africa's DJ Cutey K, USA's DJ Holla, and Voices of USA.

Founded on the South African philosophy of Ubuntu, or "I am because we are," I Am, We Are (IAWA) is dedicated to creating a world where all youth are socially engaged, globally aware, and economically free. We strive to empower youth across Africa and her Diaspora with the tools to confidently own their futures.


We work with youth ages 12-25 of African descent who are challenged to pursue their ambitions because of constraints imposed on them by their environment. IAWA employs an adaptive, socio-ecological model that enables youth to be instruments and agents of their own development, while ensuring their environment is a positive, safe space that supports their universal well-being.

IAWA is a registered non-profit organization in the United States of America (EIN #47-4382487) and the Republic of South Africa (NPC 2016/412074/08), with programming centered in South Africa's Royal Bafokeng Nation (RBN). After concluding a successful pilot in RBN in 2018, IAWA is expanding programming to include the Washington, DC metropolitan area.

The South Africa and USA programs will be integrated and work together in the spirit of cooperative liberation. Cooperative liberation recognizes that our common humanity unites us in our struggles and in our achievements. In doing so, we will permit youth across Africa and her Diaspora to recognize their commonalities and see beyond their differences. Further, they will gain global and historical context for the challenges they face on a personal, familial, and communal level. In doing so, they will learn they are not alone.
